Summertime Kölsch

3.5%

It's no wonder that as the temperature rises, Goose Islands brewers' thoughts turn to Kölsch. Light and refreshing, this beer has subtleties that will have you coming back for more. This German Ale is brewed with authentic Kölsch yeast imported from Germany and served in a traditional Kölsch glass for \$3.

Honker's Ale

3.5%

The Flagship ale of Goose Island. Gold Medal Winner in 1998 & 2000, Honker's possesses a rich malt middle and gentle hop finish. Brewed at our Fulton St. Microbrewery with pale, wheat, caramel malts, and just a touch of roasted barley. Honker's unique hop flavor comes from Styrian Goldings hops.

Hexnut Brown Ale

4.5%

BEST ENGLISH STYLE BROWN ALE AT THE 2001 REAL ALE FESTIVAL!!! This rich, full-bodied English brown ale is known for its exceptional character and friendly flavor. Sweet and not too bitter, Hexnut is an all time favorite.

Blonde Ale

4.0%

A 1999 Gold Medal winner at the Great American Beer Festival, Blonde is brewed with pale and wheat malts with a bit of aromatic malt for flavor. Liberal use of Oregon Mt. Hood hops lends to a pleasant floral nose and makes this one easy drinking pint.

Smooth India Pale Ale

6.0%

WINNER OF THE GOLD MEDAL FOR BEST ENGLISH-STYLE IPA AT THE 2000 GREAT AMERICAN BEER FESTIVAL! A hop lover's dream! Our IPA is brewed with only one malt, but liberally hopped with Centennial, Fuggle and Cascades for a huge, fresh hop flavor and long hoppy finish. Nitrogen charged for a beautiful cascade, thick, tight head and smooth easy drinking. In all honesty a gorgeous pint.

Oktoberfest

5.5%

Goose Island's Oktoberfest is a copper colored lager brewed in traditional Bavarian fashion. Slightly sweet with a big malty middle, this beer is perfect for celebrating the beginning of the fall season.

Smoked Porter

6.0%

We smoke Pale malt over Cherry wood in our own kitchen to add a distinct smoky finish to our Smoked Porter. Goes great with BBQ or an after dinner Cigar!

Demolition 1800 Ale

7.8%

Hops, hops and more hops make our Golden Strong Ale special. Over 30 pounds of Czech Saaz and Styrian Goldings are used per 10-barrel batch for one of the hoppiest brews anywhere. Served in a Belgian Ale glass, for full flavor enjoyment, for \$5.00.

Anniversary Ale

4.5%

Available again on draft and in bottles, this year's ale was brewed to the Extra Special Bitter style. Four American hops-Chinook, Tomahawk, Centennial and Ahtanum-were blended for aromatic delight.

Fest Bok

5.7%

Our special Goose Fest creation. A malty Dutch style "Ale Bok" which was standard before the popularity of German Lagers, at which point all Bocks became known as "Lagers."

Oatzen

5.0%

Another Goose Island original, fermented with our German Weizen yeast, but brewed with oats instead of wheat. All the refreshing character of a weizen, with a rich creamy finish from oats. Highly hopped with Saaz and Tettnang and served in a pint glass.

Honker's Deluxe

3.5%

Our flagship beer has found its roots in this delightful brew: a gentle pint of our award-winning ale with slight modifications. Honker's Deluxe is made with pale, wheat and caramel malts and the characteristic Styrian Goldings hops. More Styrian Goldings dry hopped in the firkin adds extra flavor and delicate nose.

Real Oatmeal Stout

4.5%

Try our classic House Stout served from a traditional beer engine. This stout is still brewed with 10% oats for that great creamy body, but it's cask-aged and served real ale style for a true gentle pint.
